#### START-UP GRANT

The NAA Foundation offers a grant of up to \$2,500 to help at-risk high school newspapers participate in the Young Publishers program. In order to receive the grant, a high school must:

- Agree to start and document a business-side development program;
- Demonstrate that its student newspaper is either struggling to exist or has ceased to exist;
- Have a high proportion of minority students OR be located in and draw its students from a rural area.

#### HOW TO APPLY

Complete this application form. Attach a report with the following information (limit 500 words):

- History and current status of the struggling high school newspaper or newspaper that has ceased publication, including the frequency of publication, the number of students involved, and the newspaper budget;
- Provide a detailed budget of how grant funds will be used (dollar amounts for purchase of equipment, incentive programs, teacher compensation, training programs and the like);
- A description of the proposed partnership between the newspaper, high school and local business volunteer, and how success of the program will be determined;
- An outline of the proposed business plan, including expected revenue sources and expenditures and noting proposed changes to revenue sources.

Applications must be submitted to the NAA Foundation at least five weeks before the program starts.

#### REVIEW PROCESS

The NAA Foundation will review the application and respond within five weeks. The review process may include several phone conversations with all participants to verify the information given in the application.
